Saturday, July 17 SSAS Members' Excursion to Historic Cemeteries of Central Illinois

Let's get out and about for a day trip! SSAS invites all members and their guests to join us on **Saturday**, **July 17** for an OPEN AIR adventure, as Ms. Holly Labisky of the IAAA takes us on a tour of significant central Illinois cemeteries.

Gather between 9:30 and 10:00 AM at the Walmart Supercenter in Lincoln, Illinois (825 Malerich Drive), just east of Exit 126 on I-55 (see insert page.) This will give everyone a chance to make a "pit stop" if needed.

We will proceed according to the itinerary and general directions below. All times are approximate. Holly will lead our caravan to all locations. No one will need to find their own way or navigate on their own.



At 10:00 AM we will hop on I-55 for a short drive south to Elkhart, Illinois (Exit 115 on I-55) and the Latham-Thompson Cemetery just east of town. After a brief look at the Latham Cemetery, we will travel south to the Elkhart Cemetery on Chapel Road. This is a significant cemetery on the historic Edwards Trace, which ran between Cahokia and Peoria, and was important in the early settlement of Illinois by Euro-Americans. Holly will provide both a tour and activities for self-guided exploration.

Between 11:30 and 12:00, we will break for lunch at the Wild Hare Café in Elkhart (intersection of S. Latham Street & Gov. Oglesby Street). **NOTE:** We are

requesting that each participant pay in cash for his/her own lunch. Please be sure to add in tax and tip. Will Kelley will collect all monies and pay our group's bill (no separate checks). If you would like to peruse the Wild Hare menu selections, visit http://www.wildharecafe-elk-il.com/

After lunch we will head north to the Old Bethel Church and Cemetery, on County Highway 20, just three miles east of Emden, Illinois. This tour also includes an activity, and could last between 30 to 45 minutes. Time and weather conditions permitting, we may also take in another cemetery on the Edwards Trace, about eight miles northeast of Bethel Church - the old cemetery near Armington, Illinois.

Our excursion should conclude by 3:30-4:00 PM, at the latest. Please wear comfortable walking shoes and weather-appropriate clothing. Facemasks are not required for our tour but <u>may</u> be requested by the restaurant. Holly will have water available for our group.

Directions to Walmart Supercenter in Lincoln, Illinois

From Homewood, we would normally recommend taking I-80 to I-55 and exiting at the Lincoln/Mason City IL Exit 126. However, due to extensive construction on the stretch of I-80 that runs through Joliet, you may want to consider the following alternative:

- 1. Take I-57 south to the Wilmington Road exit and go west to US 53.
- 2. Go south (left) on US 53 until you reach W. Coal City Road.
- 3. Go west (right) on Coal City Road until you reach I-55.
- 4. Go south on I-55.
- 5. Take Exit 126 (IL 10/121-Lincoln/Mason City).
- 6. Turn left (east). Walmart Supercenter is 1.31 miles on the right.
- 7. Facing the front of the store, look for Holly's green Ford Windstar van in the right-hand area of the lot.
- 8. For questions or assistance, call Will Kelley.
